Participation

- Full and effective participation of all States Members of the United Nations and States members of specialized agencies (All States formula – 193 members + Cook Islands, Niue, Holy See and State of Palestine);
- Intergovernmental organizations and entities with GA or ECOSOC Observer Status; and
- UN system entities.

Participation of Major Groups and other Stakeholders



- The HLPF is open to MGoS (GA res. 67/290, OP-14);
- MGoS allowed (GA res. 67/290, OP-15):
 - (a) To attend all official meetings of the forum;
 - (b) To have access to all official information and documents;
 - (c) To intervene in official meetings;
 - (d) To submit documents and present written and oral contributions;
 - (e) To make recommendations;
 - (f) To organize side events and round tables, in cooperation with Member States and the Secretariat.



HLPF/HLS of ECOSOC in July

- GA resolution **67/290**: HLPF under the auspices of ECOSOC to be convened for eight days;
- GA resolution **68/1**: the 3-day ministerial meetings to be held during the high-level segment of ECOSOC;
- GA resolution **70/299**: President of ECOSOC to jointly convene the HLS and the 3-day ministerial meetings of HLPF.

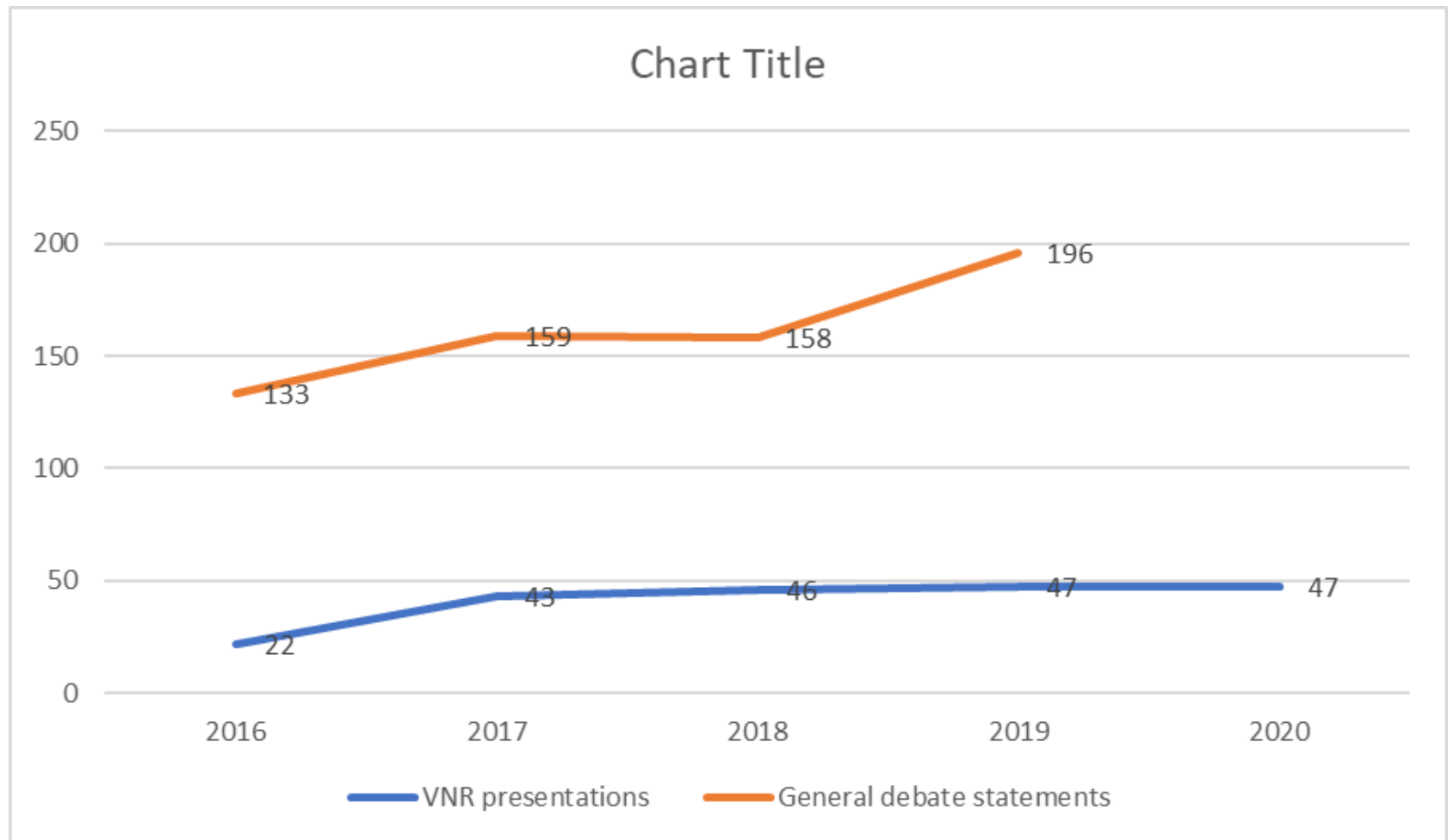

- 66/288 “The future we want” 27 July 2012 - Establishment of HLPF (para. 84, Annex);
- 67/290 9 July 2013 – Format and modalities of HLPF;
- 70/299 29 July 2016– Follow-up and review of HLPF;
- 74/298 12 August 2020 - Review of process of HLPF (in conjunction with ECOSOC)
- Reviews to be conducted during 75th session (2021).



HLPF follow-up and review - 2021

- GA resolution **70/299, OP-21** – decided to review progress in implementing the resolution and resolution 67/290 on the format and organizational aspects of the HLPF.
- GA resolution **72/305, Op-32** and **74/298, OP-2**- “in conjunction” with ECOSOC strengthening process.
- Co-Facilitators- PRs of Austria and Senegal.
