# Role and functions of the President and Bureau

- Elected at organizational session (July)
- Regional rotation and special responsibilities (rule 18)
- General powers of the President (rule 42)
- Coordinate the work and prepare decisions on behalf of the membership, consult
- Additional guidance: Paras. 31-33 of GA res. [68/1](#) and paras. 13, 25 and 27 of [72/305](#), para. 14 of [75/290A](#)
- President raises awareness and promotes engagement

# Management segment

- 2 Management segments during the 2022 cycle (8-9 June and 21-22 July)
- Resolution [72/305](#): focus on the adoption of procedural decisions, consideration of recommendations of subsidiary bodies, introduction of reports and consideration of draft proposals submitted under relevant agenda items
- Resolution [75/290A](#): Integrate the key messages from the subsidiary bodies of the Council and the UN system on the main theme, develop recommendations for follow-up and feed into HLPF
- 10 of 19 agenda items
- Bulk of formal decision-making (In 2020, 18 of 23 resolutions. 25 of 33 decisions. In 2021, 26 of 32 resolutions; 43 of 62 decisions.)

# Elections

- Elections for most regular vacancies to be held at 13 April Management meeting; outstanding vacancies can be considered *ad hoc*
- ECOSOC conducts elections of members of 26 subsidiary and related bodies (Functional commissions, Executive Boards, Peacebuilding Commission) – regular elections to 14 bodies in 2022
- Agreed candidate/slate – can be elected without vote
- Secret ballot, if requested (rule 68)
- Documentation (E/2022/100/Add.1, E/2022/9 and Addenda – to be issued)
- Use of ‘Candiweb’ (under e-delegate - Elections)

# Decision-making

- Decisions/resolutions adopted either without a vote or, at the request of a member, by recorded vote
- Each member has one vote (rule 58); Majority of those present and voting (rule 60)
- Source of proposals:
  - Contained in reports of subsidiary bodies
  - Draft proposals either by a delegation/group of delegations or President's/Vice-President's text
- Practice of consensus – in 2021, 28 of 32 resolutions and 61 of 62 decisions adopted without a vote.
- 2021 FfD outcome – adopted without a vote
- 2021 HLPF/HLS ministerial declaration – voting on para./amendments – as a whole without a vote

# Participation of non-Member States

- Rule 72 provides for participation of States non-members of the Council (also Article 69 of the Charter)
- States not members of the Council may submit and co-sponsor draft proposals – put to action at request of a member
- Inclusive approach (rule 72, order of speakers, practice in negotiation of draft ministerial declaration and other draft resolutions)

# Adapting to COVID-19 constraints

- Adjusted to virtual environment
- 2020: Allowed decision-making through silence procedure (extended to subsidiary bodies)
- Adjusted ECOSOC's calendar of meeting
- 2020: conducted elections through silence procedure; conducted virtual negotiations
- September 2020 – return to in-person meetings
- 2021 HLPF (incl. VNRs) held mainly virtually
- Currently – in-person and informal virtual meetings – adjust to evolving situation

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
